

## COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

The Grant County Board of Commissioners met in a Public Hearing, Monday, March 15, 2010 at 8:45 a.m. Notice of the Meeting, including agenda, was posted on the First Floor Bulletin Board and at entrances of the Grant County Courthouse, Medford, Oklahoma, March 11, 2010, in accordance with Title 25, Section 301-314.
